March 3rd-The Busan-Jinhae Free Economic Zone will be hosting India's TATA group as they tour the

BJFEZ area during a five day tour of Korean market.

Senior level officers from TATA's divisions will begin with a brief session at the FEZ Authority

headquarters followed by a tour of the New Port as well as a Geoga bridge, which will connect Busan to

Geoje Island, the heart of Korea's shipbuilding industry.

The TATA group is India's largest publicly traded and family owned company. Established in 1868 by

Jansetji Nusserwanji Tata, the company has grown into a multi-billion dollar conglomerate producing

everything from salt to steel. In FY 08-09, Tata group reported \$70.9 bn USD in revenues with a market

 $capitalization \ of \ \textbf{1,298} \ bn \ USD. \ Under \ its \ current \ CEO \ Ratan \ Tata, \ the \ conglomerate \ has \ produced \ the \ Tata$

Nano, India's first indigenously produced vehicle and has acquired prestigious car maker Jaguar/Land

Rover as well as the Anglo-Dutch Steel consortium.
