Woongdong Tourism & Leisure Agreement/MOU Signed



December 22nd, 2009- An Enforcement agreement related to the MOU to develop the Ungdong Tourism & Leisure project of the Busan-Jinhae Free Economic Zone (BJFEZ) was signed at the Gyeongnam Provinical Office in Changwon. The Enforcement signees involved Gyeongsangnam-do Governor Kim Tae-ho, Kim Moon-hee, Commissioner of the BJFEZ, Shim Hee-bum, President of the Gyeongnam Development Corporation (GDC), Kim Ho-ki, Vice-Mayor of Jinhae City, Choi Jung-ho, the President of the Youngwon Development Corporation and Youngwon-STX consortium's Kim Kook-hyun, CEO of the STX construction company.

Details of the agreement to establish a world class tourism & leisure complex include a 307 billion won investment by the Youngwon-STX consortium on 2.3 million m² (557 acres) of Ungdong district's reclaimed land. Construction will take place over two phases-first phase construction calls for a 30 hole public golf course, water park and marina to be built between 2010 and 2013. Second phase construction will include luxury hotel, casino, foreign hospital and foreign educational institutions from 2016 to 2018.

Related to the Tourism & Leisure complex is the \$100 million US dollar MOU also entered into between U.S. Development Group (USDG), Acrylic Tank Manufacturing (ATM) and Water Park & Aquarium Development Company, along with American Construction Management (CM) and investor-Turner International. USDG has pledged U.S. \$50 million to build the eco-friendly resort with ATM pledging U.S. \$50 million to build the aquarium water park. Turner International will provide the technical and CM support for the project along with financing if the need arises. As of 2007, Korea ranked 8th in the world for R&D expenditures with 33.7 billion U.S- 3.47% of GDP. In

actual number terms R&D centers focused on development with industrial application has jumped from

373 in 1997 to 1,072 in 2005. Much of the R&D focus has been on supplying parts & materials to Korean

manufacturers as opposed to pure R&D activities.

The FEZ Authority is particularly interested in R&D with industrial applications as both Mieum and

Namoon districts have been designated as parts & materials industrial parks to address the first and

second tier supply needs of the area's key industries: shipbuilding, automotive manufacturing and

machinery manufacturing.
